What Should Define A Church?
Generosity, Miracles, Biblical Preaching

1) Generosity is a heart condition, not a physical outpouring.

Acts 4:32-34 (NASB) ³² And the congregation of those who believed were of one heart and soul; and not one of them claimed that anything belonging to him was his own, but all things were common property to them. ³³ And with great power the apostles were giving testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and abundant grace was upon them all. ³⁴ For there was not a needy person among them, for all who were owners of land or houses would sell them and bring the proceeds of the sales

Psalms 37:26 (NASB) They are always generous and lend freely; their children will be a blessing.

2) Unity provides an environment for miracles.

Acts 5:14-16 (NASB) And all the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men and women, were constantly added to their number, ¹⁵ to such an extent that they even carried the sick out into the streets and laid them on cots and pallets, so that when Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on any one of them. ¹⁶ Also the people from the cities in the vicinity of Jerusalem were coming together, bringing people who were sick or afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all being healed

Matthew 10:1 (NASB) Jesus summoned His twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

3) I just can't shut up about Jesus.

Acts 5:29 (NASB) But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men.

Acts 4:31(NASB) And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness.
