John 10: 7-11 Therefore Jesus said again, "Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who have come before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full. I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

Father, help me to live this day to the full, being true to You in every way!

1) The Thief's Purpose: To Steal, Kill, and Destroy.

The Greek word for “thief” is kleptes, meaning one who steals by stealth – the same root from which we get kleptomaniac.

1 Peter 5:8 (NLT): “Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.”

2) The Shepherd's Care: Personal, Protective, Powerful.

John 10:11 NLT I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd sacrifices his life for the sheep.

3) Christ's Purpose: To Give Life to the Full – Abundant, Eternal, Transforming.

"I have come that they may have life and have it to the full."

Piper wrote: "God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him."

John 4:30-34 they came out of the town and made their way toward him. Meanwhile his disciples urged him, "Rabbi, eat something." But he said to them, "I have food to eat that you know nothing about." Then his disciples said to each other, "Could someone have brought him food?" "My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work."

4) The Call: Live in the Fullness of Christ.

“Tim Keller once said: “The gospel is not that we give God a good record, but that He gives us Jesus’ perfect record.”

Jesus says in **John 10:9 (NLT)**: "I am the gate. Those who come in through me will be saved."

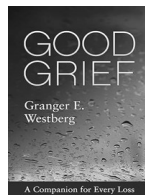
