1) What are you having for lunch today?

Acts 10:9-10 About noon the following day as they were on their journey and approaching the city, Peter went up on the roof to pray. 10 He became hungry and wanted something to eat, and while the meal was being prepared, he fell into a trance.

Psalm 17:6 I call on you, my God, for you will answer me; turn your ear to me and hear my prayer.

John 17:15 My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.

2) It is important that we respect and honor people.

Acts 10:22-23 & 25-26 ²² The men replied, "We have come from Cornelius the centurion. He is a righteous and God-fearing man, who is respected by all the Jewish people. A holy angel told him to ask you to come to his house so that he could hear what you have to say." ²³ Then Peter invited the men into the house to be his guests. ²⁵ As Peter entered the house, Cornelius met him and fell at his feet in reverence. ²⁶ But Peter made him get up. "Stand up," he said, "I am only a man myself."

Acts 10:31 and said, 'Cornelius, God has heard your prayer and remembered your gifts to the poor.

Proverbs 3:35 The wise inherit honor, but fools get only shame.

3) How do you think Christ sees us? How do we see Him?

Acts 10:34-35 Then Peter began to speak: "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism ³⁵ but accepts from every nation the one who fears him and does what is right.

Acts 10: 38-43 (He did it all for Us) The Jesus story

We need to allow God to do what only God can do.

Acts 10:44-45 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. ⁴⁵ The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles.

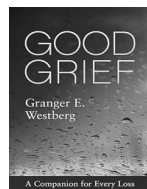
