**FROM THE BOTTOM UP**

**1) Do not avoid doing what He prompts you to do.**

**John 13: 3-5** Jesus knew that the Father had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God; <sup>4</sup> so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. <sup>5</sup> After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him.

**James 1:19-20** My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, <sup>20</sup> because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.

**2) Clean feet does not equal a clean heart.**

**John 13:10-11** Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet; otherwise he is completely clean. And you are clean—but not all of you." <sup>11</sup> For He knew the one who was betraying Him; it was for this reason that He said, "Not all of you are clean."

**Psalms 51:10** Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

**3) We should never use our status to condemn others.**

**John 13: 13-17** "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. <sup>14</sup> Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. <sup>15</sup> I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. <sup>16</sup> Very truly I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. <sup>17</sup> Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them.

**4) They will know we are Christians by our love.**

**John 13: 34-35** "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."
