## HOW DIRTY ARE YOUR FEET?

1) **Sometimes people need to hear about your past before they know there is hope for the future.**

**Acts 13:14-16** But going on from Perga, they arrived at Pisidian Antioch, and on the Sabbath day they went into the synagogue and sat down. <sup>15</sup> After the reading of the Law and the Prophets the synagogue officials sent to them, saying, "Brethren, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say it." <sup>16</sup> Paul stood up, and motioning with his hand said, Men of Israel, and you who fear God, listen, Men of Israel, and you who fear God, listen

2) **We need to continually hunger and thirst for more.**

**Acts 13: 42-43 (NASB)** As Paul and Barnabas were going out, the people kept begging that these things might be spoken to them the next Sabbath. <sup>43</sup> Now when the meeting of the synagogue had broken up, many of the Jews and of the God-fearing proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, were urging them to continue in the grace of God

**Matthew 5:6 (NASB)** "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

3) **Round two.**

**Acts 13:44-45(NASB)** And the next Sabbath nearly the whole city assembled to hear the word of the Lord. <sup>45</sup> But when the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and began contradicting the things spoken by Paul, and were blaspheming.

**Acts 13:47** For the Lord has commanded us, I have placed you as a light for the gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the end of the earth

4) **Don't let the dirt hurt.**

**Acts 13:50-52** But the Jews incited the devout women of prominence and the leading men of the city, and instigated a persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of their district. <sup>51</sup> But they shook off the dust of their feet in protest against them and went to Iconium. <sup>52</sup> And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.
