BE CAREFUL THAT THE ROCK YOU THROW MAY BECOME YOURS

1. It is easy to go from Hero to Zero.

Acts 14: 11-12 When the crowds saw what Paul had done, they raised their voice, saying in the Lycaonian language, "The gods have become like men and have come down to us!" ¹² And they began calling Barnabas, Zeus, and Paul, Hermes, since he was the chief speaker.

Acts 14:19-20 But Jews came from Antioch and Iconium, and having won over the crowds, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, thinking that he was dead. ²⁰ But while the disciples stood around him, he got up and entered the city. The next day he left with Barnabas for Derbe.

Acts 7:58-60 When they had driven him out of the city, they began stoning him; and the witnesses laid aside their cloaks at the feet of a young man named Saul. ⁵⁹ They went on stoning Stephen as he called on the Lord and said, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit!" ⁶⁰ Then he fell on his knees and cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them!" Having said this, he fell asleep.

2. Allow your life to be an example of perseverance.

Acts 14:21-22 And after they had preached the gospel to that city and had made a good number of disciples, they returned to Lystra, to Iconium, and to Antioch, ²² strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and saying, "It is through many tribulations that we must enter the kingdom of God."

James 1:12 Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

3. Our tests can become our testimonies.

Acts 14:27-28 When they had arrived and gathered the church together, they began to report all the things that God had done with them and how He had opened a door of faith to the Gentiles. ²⁸ And they spent a long time with the disciples.

James 1:3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance.
