HE IS OUR GOD AND WE ARE HIS PEOPLE

1) HE IS THE NAME ABOVE EVERY NAME. HE IS THE ONE TRUE KING.

Psalm 33:12-13 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, The people He has chosen for His own inheritance. ¹³ The Lord looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of mankind;

Revelation 19:16 And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written: "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."

Philippians 2:9-11 For this reason also God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

2) WE ARE FREE BECAUSE OF THE CROSS, NOT BECAUSE OF MAN.

Galatians 5:13-15 For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but serve one another through love. ¹⁴ For the whole Law is fulfilled in one word, in the statement, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵ But if you bite and devour one another, take care that you are not consumed by one another.

3) SALT & LIGHT SHOULD ALWAYS OUTLAST US.

Matthew 5:13-16 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by people. ¹⁴ "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵ nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Your light must shine before people in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

John 8:12 Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; the one who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."
