I WAS BLIND BUT NOW I SEE

1) LISTEN TO THOSE WHO GOD SENDS TO YOU.

Proverbs 18:13 To answer before listening— that is folly and shame.

Acts 9:10-12 In Damascus there was a disciple named Ananias. The Lord called to him in a vision, "Ananias! "Yes, Lord," he answered. ¹¹ The Lord told him, "Go to the house of Judas on Straight Street and ask for a man from Tarsus named Saul, for he is praying. ¹² In a vision he has seen a man named Ananias come and place his hands on him to restore his sight."

Acts 9:17-19 Then Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit." ¹⁸ Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized, ¹⁹ and after taking some food, he regained his strength.

2) WHAT DO TRANSFORMED PEOPLE LOOK LIKE?

Luke 15:11-32 (THE PRODIGAL SON)

Acts 9:20 & 22 Saul spent several days with the disciples in Damascus. At once he began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God. ²² Yet Saul grew more and more powerful and baffled the Jews living in Damascus by proving that Jesus is the Messiah.

Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

3) IT'S HARD TO TRUST WHEN YOUR PAST IS TAINTED. IT TAKES TIME.

Acts 9:23-24 & 29-30 After many days had gone by, there was a conspiracy among the Jews to kill him, ²⁴ but Saul learned of their plan. Day and night they kept close watch on the city gates in order to kill him. ²⁹ He talked and debated with the Hellenistic Jews, but they tried to kill him. ³⁰ But when the brethren learned of it they brought him down to Caesarea and sent him away to Tarus.

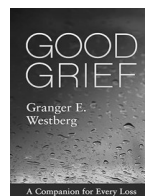
