Joshua chapters 1-3

1) GOD IS ALWAYS PREPARING THE NEXT PERSON AND IT MIGHT JUST BE YOU.

Deuteronomy 34:4 Then the Lord said to him, "This is the land which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, 'I will give it to your descendants'; I have let you see it with your eyes, but you shall not go over there."

Joshua 1:1-2 be ready to listen and slow to speak

Now it came about after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' servant, saying, 2 "Moses My servant is dead; now therefore arise, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel.

2) BE HUMBLE, BUT BOLD.

Joshua 1:9-12 9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." 10 Then Joshua commanded the officers of the people, saying, 11 "Pass through the midst of the camp and command the people, saying, 'Prepare provisions for yourselves, for within three days you are to cross this Jordan, to go in to possess the land which the Lord your God is giving you, to possess it.'"

3) YOUR EXAMPLE GOES BEFORE YOU: HE WILL SEND YOU THE MOST UNLIKELY PEOPLE.

Joshua 2 : 3-5 And the king of Jericho sent word to Rahab, saying, "Bring out the men who have come to you, who have entered your house, for they have come to search out all the land." 4 But the woman had taken the two men and hidden them, and she said, "Yes, the men came to me, but I did not know where they were from. 5 It came about when it was time to shut the gate at dark, that the men went out; I do not know where the men went. Pursue them quickly, for you will overtake them.

4) YOUR OATH TO AN UNBELIEVER SAYS A GREAT DEAL OF YOUR FAITHFULNESS TO GOD.

Joshua 2: 20-21 20 But if you tell this business of ours, then we shall be free from the oath which you have made us swear." 21 She said, "According to your words, so be it." So she sent them away, and they departed; and she tied the scarlet cord in the window.
