Ministry Moments Are All Around Us

1) Don't walk by the obvious.

Acts 9:32-33 Now as Peter was traveling through all those regions, he came down also to the saints who lived at Lydda.³³ There he found a man named Aeneas, who had been bedridden eight years, for he was paralyzed.

Luke 10:25-37 (Parable of the Good Samaritan)

2) Don't be afraid to ask God for what appears to be impossible.

Acts 9:34-35 Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you; get up and make your bed." Immediately he got up.³⁵ And all who lived at Lydda and Sharon saw him, and they turned to the Lord.

Acts 9:40-42 But Peter sent them all out and knelt down and prayed, and turning to the body, he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter, she sat up.⁴¹ And he gave her his hand and raised her up; and calling the saints and widows, he presented her alive.⁴² It became known all over Joppa, and many believed in the Lord.

Luke 1:37 "Nothing is impossible with God"

3) Your fruits produce favor.

Acts 10:1-2 & 4 Now there was a man at Caesarea named Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian cohort,² a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, and gave many alms to the Jewish people and prayed to God continually.⁴ And fixing his gaze on him and being much alarmed, he said, "What is it, Lord?" And he said to him, "Your prayers and alms have ascended as a memorial before God.

Acts 10:22-23 They said, "Cornelius, a centurion, a righteous and God-fearing man well spoken of by the entire nation of the Jews, was divinely directed by a holy angel to send for you to come to his house and hear a message from you."²³ So he invited them in and gave them lodging.

Galatians 5:22-23 Fruit of the Spirit - love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,²³ gentleness and self-control

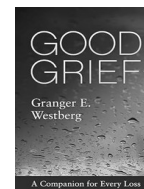
